Enemy Activities: Hostile Actions by Foreigners

From 10 to 20 February, a considerable activation of military sector employees of the diplomatic missions of the NATO countries has been noted. This coincided with the exercises of the First Army forces. The respective State Security units have taken measures for carrying out efficient counter-actions and preventing attempts for intelligence information gathering. [Minister of Defense] Comrade Dobri Djurov has been informed.

There is data that during their trips around the country, Italian military intelligence agents were using a camera with zoom lens that can take 60 shots with one push of the button. By fixing the camera on the car window, they can photograph targets when moving at the speed of 60 km/h. Counter-intelligence units in the center and the districts and the Second State Security unit have undertaken joint counter-actions and measures. The surveillance of a few determined agents of Turkish Intelligence services is being carried out successfully as well...
