

**Memorandum on Conversation between a Bulgarian (Neev) and a Czechoslovak Diplomat (Dzurenda) on the forthcoming Political Consultative Committee Meeting, 28 September 1990**

**MEMORANDUM**

On 28.09.90, at 2.30 p.m., Jozef Dzurenda, Minister Plenipotentiary–Counselor at the ČSFR Embassy, called me.

He informed me that the ČSFR accepts Hungary's proposal for a special meeting of the Warsaw Treaty Political Consultative Committee /PCC/ on 4 November, this year, in Budapest.

The ČSFR believes that the PCC meeting should deal exclusively with the questions of the transformation of the Warsaw Treaty Organization into a political organization. That's why they were against the discussion proposed of "Current Problems of the Common European Process," proposed by Hungary at the PCC meeting.
