Sug ested change of date for the Meeting of Rapporteurs and of Sub-Group 3 (AC/261)

Referring to the note which Ambassador Cleveland addressed to the Secretary General suggesting that the meeting of the five Raporteurs scheduled for the 17th May be postponed to the 19th (with subsequent repercussions on the date presently scheduled for the meeting of Sub-Group 3, 1.e. 16th May), I would like to inform you of the reactions so far received from the other four Rapporteur nations:

- Belgium: no reaction

Germany: State Secretary Schutz is on a mission in the Far East: Dr. Sahm will replace him, but is unable to come on 19th

Netherlands: Professor Patijn is in a position to accept the postponement to the 19th

Wr. Watson, Assistant Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, could equally accept 19th May.
