Subject: Second Meeting of Sub-Group No.4; on Developments in Regions outside the NATO Area

The Sub-Croup No.4 held its second meeting on Tuesday, 23rd May under the Chairmanship of Professor Patijn, the rapporteur. The Croup had before it an outline of their report, prepared by Professor Patijn. This paper contained the draft of the first two sections of their final report: Part 1 - A General Introduction, and Part 2 - A Breakdown of the Problems, into the following three categories:

- (a) Political events directly affecting the security of the Atlantic erea.
- (b) Political events not directly effecting the security of the Atlantic area.
- (c) International problems of a universal character for which the Western world has to assume part of the responsibility.
- e. After a number of statements of a general character by member representatives on this document, the Group went, paragraph by paragraph, over the dreft text and a number of suggestions were made with regard to the presentation as well as to the substance of the paper.
- 3. The Croup agreed to meet again on the 29th, and if necessary, 30th June, 1967, to review a re-draft of Port 2, propered in the light of the amendments proposed during the discussion and the first draft of the third and last part of the report on "proposals for the improvement of MATO concultation, contingency planning and crisis management".
