This assumes that we defer subject No. 7 until a later stage, with which I agree.

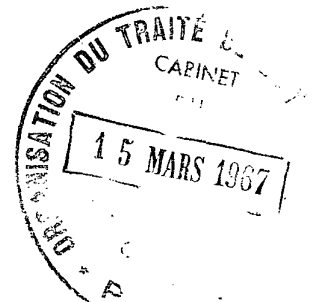

1. The political aims of the Alliance with regard to the improvement of East-West relations, bearing in mind current developments in Eastern Europe.
2. The development of defence policy, bearing in mind on the one hand proposals for arms control and disarmament, including the balanced reduction of forces, and on the other hand the continuing need for security during the process of détente.
3. The consultative process in NATO (political, military, nuclear); past suggestions and present achievements; its range, purpose and limitations; the problem of commitment; including the question of consultation and commitment with regard to regions outside the Treaty area, and the question of a European view.
