  - 2. Comments on the historical background.
  - (a) In 1967 the Alliance and its member-states are no longer confronted with tragic events of 1949 and 1940.
  - (b) A major change has occured both within the eastern countries and within the western grant powers.
    - Within the eastern countries : the Alliance has halted the communist progression in Europe.
      - A major change has occured in the relationships between the communist states : the Soviet Union is now one of the two super-powers. a serious split has arisen between Moscow and Peking, the countries. of eastern Europe show a greater tendency to take their own decisions.
      - The Communist world has given its own definition of peaceful coexistence at the 20th Congress, limiting the confrontation with the democratic states of Europe to the economic, political and idealogical teams.
