RESOLUTION No. 178

23 February 1952

on report by Minister of Foreign Affairs No 3528-60-V from 15 February 1952

REFERENCE: Support to the Korean People's Republic with foods and other materials

THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS HAS DECIDED:

1. To support the Korean People's Republic with foods and other materials in compliance with the enclosed list.
2. The goods in the enclosed list, to be granted by the Ministry of home trade, shall be allocated from the goods for the population for 1952; and the goods, granted by the Ministry of supplies and food industry and by the Ministry of light industry shall be allocated from the overstock on 1 January 1952, as well as from overproduction and savings, without disturbing the implementation plan and the supplies for institutions, approved by the Council of Ministers.
3. The goods in the enclosed list, amounting to 627 793 000 leva, shall be exempt from taxes, and the remaining amount of 384 496 000 leva shall be paid by the Ministry of finance to the above mentioned ministries on the account of the Republican budget reserve funds.
4. The goods shall be sent by the Bulgarian Red Cross, while the Ministry of transportation shall provide carriages and transport the goods free of charge

through the territories of the Romanian People's Republic, the Soviet Union  
and the Chinese People's Republic.
