RESOLUTION № 585

From 14 December 1970

REFERENCE: Negotiations about special export to the Republic of Iraq

THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

To nominate Colonel General Semerdzhiev – first deputy minister of the people's defense and chief of the General staff of the Bulgarian armed forces, as the leader of a government delegation, to hold negotiations with the Republic of Iraq and to sign a long-term agreement for special export and cooperation in the period 1969-1975.

To authorize the head of delegation to sign on behalf of the government the agreement and all enclosed documents.

Members of the delegation shall be representatives of the Ministry of foreign trade, the State planning commission, the Ministry of defense and Bulgarian foreign trade bank. All expenses related to travel and accommodation of the delegation in the Republic of Iraq shall be covered by the Ministry of foreign trade, respectively by "Kintex".
