RESOLUTION № 19
OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS
Sofia, 22 January 1970

REFERENCE: Approval of protocol for rendering free aid to the
Democratic Republic of Vietnam in 1970

THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

1. To approve the Protocol, signed in Sofia on 5 November 1969,
between the government of the People's Republic of Bulgaria and the
government of the Democratic Republic of Vietnam to render free aid
to the Democratic Republic of Vietnam in 1970.
2. To give permission to the Ministry of foreign trade, when possible, to
exchange meat-vegetable and vegetable canned food with meat and
fish cans, at the same value.
3. The funds for military technical and other equipment and
transportation expenses, included in the Republican budget for 1970,

to be transferred by the Ministry of finance to the Ministry of foreign trade.

4. The Foreign Ministry shall settle the issue of transportation of equipment through the territory of the Chinese People's Republic.
