COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

RESOLUTION № 263

Sofia, 13 June 1967

REFERENCE: Rendering free aid to the Syrian Arab Republic

1. To render to the Syrian Arab Republic:

a) Special equipment at the amount of 3.5 million currency leva.

The equipment shall be provided from the stockpiles of the Ministry of defense, except for anti-tank grenade launcher RPG-7 and ammunition for them, which shall be supplied from the stocks for export 1st destination;

b) medications at the amount of about 125 000 leva.

Medications shall be provided by the Ministry of people's health and social care;

c) foods at the amount of about 530 000 currency leva.

Goods shall be provided by the Ministry of food industry.

2. The cost of medications, foods, and special equipment (except for anti-tank weapons “Rhein metal” and ammunition) shall be paid by the Ministry of finance on the account of economies in the Republican budget.

3. Goods, packed to be transported by sea, shall be delivered in 5 days by supplying institutions to the Ministry of foreign trade – “Kintex”.

4. The Ministry of transport shall provide transportation of equipment with Bulgarian ships, the expenses shall be paid by the Ministry of foreign trade – “Kintex”.

5. “Kintex” is obliged to organize the implementation of this resolution.
