REFERENCE: Approval of Agreement between the government of the People's Republic of Bulgaria and the government of the Democratic Republic of Vietnam regarding assistance to DRV in 1965-1966

## THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

1. To approve the Agreement between the government of the People's Republic of Bulgaria and the government of the Democratic Republic of Vietnam, signed on 22 June this year in Sofia, and the enclosed documents, planning

delivery of goods and equipment at the amount of 2,3 million rubles from Bulgaria to Vietnam in 1965-1966, as well as the letter exchanged between the heads of the two delegations for provision of special equipment valued at 700 000 rubles.

- 2. The State planning committee and the Ministry of finance shall make relevant changes in the economy plan, resulting from the signed agreement.
- 3. The Committee for machine-building, the Committee for chemistry and metallurgy, the Committee for light industry, the Ministry of health and social care and the Ministry of internal trade shall prepare timely and in appropriate for export packing, the goods, specified in the Agreement, subject to their activities.

The execution of this resolution is the responsibility of the Ministry of foreign trade, the Ministry of finance, the State planning committee, the Ministry of foreign affairs, the Ministry of internal trade and other concerned institutions.
