RESOLUTION No. 786 OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS 11 MAY 1961

REFERENCE: Endorsement of the protocol regarding free economic assistance to the interim Algerian government

On Report No. 279 from 29 April 1961 of Ministry of foreign trade

THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

- 1. Endorses the protocol, signed on 29 March 1961 in Sofia, regarding rendering free economic assistance by our country to the interim Algerian government.
- 2. The goods to be delivered to the interim Algerian government shall be allocated from the regular export plan, the commodity resources, goods available in the Ministry of interior, the Ministry of defense and the state reserve, and Sofia City Hall, according to the enclosed table.

The Ministry of foreign trade shall pay for the goods from the commodity funds at wholesale prices, ensuring their transfer to a border checkpoint. The transportation expenses to the border shall be covered by the Ministry of foreign trade.

3. The cost of the goods and transportation expenses to the border shall be covered from the planned credits for losses of the Ministry of foreign trade for 1961. Necessary foreign currency for transportation of goods by sea shall be allocated from the limit of the foreign currency plan of the Ministry of foreign trade for 1961.

The execution of this order is the responsibility of the Ministry of foreign trade, State planning commission, the Ministry of home trade, the Ministry of people's defense, the Ministry of interior, the Ministry of finance, and the executive committee of Sofia City Hall.
