COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

RESOLUTION № 1

5 January 1979

REFERENCE: Rendering free aid to the People's Republic of
Mozambique

THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

1. To render the People's Republic of Mozambique free aid – military-technical equipment at the amount of 1 300 000 leva, as per Appendices 1 and 2.

The Ministry of defense shall provide the equipment from stockpiles and deliver it to “Kintex” in suitable packing ready for transportation.

The Ministry of finance shall provide the Ministry of foreign trade – “Kintex” with funds for transportation of equipment to the People's Republic of Mozambique.

The Ministry of foreign trade – “Kintex” shall organize transportation of equipment to the People's Republic of Mozambique, as soon as possible.

The Ministry of transportation – Balkan Bulgarian Airlines, shall give priority to transportation of the equipment to PR Mozambique.

Foreign Ministry shall render full support to Balkan Bulgarian Airlines to get flight permission en route to Maputo.

The State planning committee and the Ministry of finance shall replenish the stocks of equipment of the Ministry of defense by the end of 1980.

2. To give a credit to the PR Mozambique for delivery of military-technical equipment.

The Minister of foreign trade shall hold negotiations on the amount and terms of the credit, and sign respective documents.
