COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

RESOLUTION № 190

21 August 1987

REFERENCE: Providing free aid and giving a credit to the Republic of
Burkina Faso

THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

1. To provide free aid to the Republic of Burkina Faso for delivery of armament, equipment, and mainly for training of personnel at the higher military institutions of the Ministry of defense, at the amount of 600 000 leva, including transportation expenses for delivery of armament and equipment.

The Ministry of defense shall provide the types and quantities of armament and equipment, and shall specify together with the Ministry of defense of Republic Burkina Faso the number of personnel to be trained in our military institutions, within this assistance.

Delivery of equipment shall be completed by “Kintex”.

The State planning committee and the Ministry of finance shall provide recourses in leva and foreign currency, and replenishment of equipment.

2. "Kintex" shall give the Republic of Burkina Faso a company credit at the amount of 9 000 000 currency leva for delivery of military and technical equipment, under the following conditions for state credit:

- advance payment – 15-20 %;
- period – 3 years;
- interest in accordance with the conditions at the international market.

The beginning of credit shall be in 1988.
