COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

RESOLUTION № 261

OF THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

30 December 1986

REFERENCE: Providing free aid and giving a credit for special and supply equipment to the United Republic of Tanzania

THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

1. To provide free aid to United Republic of Tanzania at the amount of 1 million leva (including transportation expenses and insurance), in accordance with the enclosed list.
2. To give a credit for delivery of special and supply equipment to the United Republic of Tanzania, at the amount of 5 million US dollars, under the following conditions:
  - advance payment – 5 %;
  - pay off – 8 years;
  - privileged period – 12 months;

- interest – 4 %.
- 3. The Ministry of trade shall hold negotiations and sign an agreement for a credit for delivery of special and supply equipment to the United Republic of Tanzania.
- 4. “Kintex” shall organize the delivery of the equipment to the United Republic of Tanzania.
