RESOLUTION № 92
OF THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

13 May 1986

REFERENCE: Evacuation of Bulgarian citizens from the Socialist
people's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya

THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

1. To approve the plan for evacuation of Bulgarian citizens from the
Socialist people's Libyan Arab Djamahiria, as per Enclosure.

The implementation of the plan is the responsibility of the Minister of
trade, the Minister of foreign affairs, the Minister of transportation and the
ambassador of PR Bulgaria to the Socialist people's Libyan Arab Djamahiria.

The Minister of trade is in charge of the overall organization and control
over the evacuation.

2. Foreign Ministry shall send a special request to the competent Soviet
authorities to evacuate Bulgarian citizens from Libya on Soviet ships, specifying
their exact number.

The Ministry of finance shall provide foreign currency to pay for the Soviet involvement in the evacuation, as well as for all expenses, related to the evacuation of Bulgarian citizens from Libya.

3. Foreign Ministry shall give instructions to the ambassadors of PR Bulgaria to Algeria, Tunis, Malta, Egypt, Greece, Cyprus and SFR Yugoslavia, when necessary, to request the use of their ports and airfields for the evacuation of Bulgarian citizens from Libya, and to provide necessary living conditions there.
