RESOLUTION № 88 OF THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS From 30 April 1986

REFERENCE: Providing free aid to Republic of Nicaragua

THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

- 1. In addition to the 20 000 tons of oil, delivered in 1985 free of charge, to deliver 20 000 tons of oil in 1986 at amounts of 9 261 000 currency leva.
- 2. To increase the investment credit by 10 million USD, the credit for delivery of machines by 5 million USD according to the signed on 27 January 1981 agreements, in order to finish building the installations in order to complete the industrial cycle.

- To give to the Republic of Nicaragua a new credit of 10 million USD for special equipment on the terms of the Agreement, signed on 27 January 1981
- 4. Ministry of trade to led negotiations with the Nicaraguan side and to sign the necessary documents.
