RESOLUTION № 62

OF THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

7 May 1983

REFERENCE: Rendering free aid – military-technical and other
equipment to the People's Republic of Angola

THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

To render the People's Republic of Angola free aid – military-technical
and other equipment at the amount of 3 000 000 leva, as per Enclosure.

The Ministry of defense and the Ministry of interior shall provide the
equipment, specified in the enclosure, from their stockpiles, and the Ministry of
machine-building and electronics – from production.

The Ministry of foreign trade, respectively “Kintex”, shall provide transportation of equipment to PR Angola.

The Ministry of finance shall provide up to 760 000 leva for transportation, including foreign currency.

The State planning committee and the Ministry of finance shall replenish the stocks of equipment of the Ministry of defense and the Ministry of interior in 1984, and pay for 50 radio telephones to the Ministry of machine-building and electronics.
