RESOLUTION № 34  
OF THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS  
From 7 March 1983

REFERENCE: Rendering free aid to the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan

THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS  
ORDERS:

1. The Ministry of defense to provide free aid to the Ministry of defense of Afghanistan on the account of its budget, as follows:
  - a) During the period 1983-1985, to accept annually 5 patients for hospital treatment and 10 patients for sanatorium treatment, total number 15 men for hospital treatment and 30 for sanatorium treatment;
  - b) To deliver medications for 20 000 leva and logistic and medical equipment for 30 000 leva.
2. The Ministry of people's health to provide artificial limbs to 15 Afghan militaries.

3. The Ministry of transportation and “Kintex” to ensure the transportation of the provided equipment for Democratic Republic of Afghanistan.
4. The State planning committee and the Ministry of finance shall provide the Ministry of defense, the Ministry of people’s health and the Ministry of foreign trade with necessary funds in foreign currency and in leva for artificial limbs, for return tickets from Kabul to Sofia, as well as for transportation of equipment.
