COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

RESOLUTION № 189

21 December 1981

REFERENCE: Rendering free aid – military-technical equipment to the
People’s Republic of Angola

THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

To render the People’s Republic of Angola free aid – military-technical
equipment at the amount of 1 400 000 leva, as per Enclosure.

The Ministry of defense shall provide the equipment from its stockpiles
and deliver it to the Ministry of foreign trade – “Kintex”, which shall organize
transportation to PR Angola.

The Ministry of finance shall provide “Kintex” with up to 600 000 leva and
necessary foreign currency to cover transportation expenses.

The State planning committee and the Ministry of finance shall replenish the stocks of equipment of the Ministry of defense in 1982 and 1983.
