Compilation of significant issues of cooperation brought up with allied military Authorities

- A. Issues initiated by the Swedish headquarters
- 1. Supply issues regarding allied naval forces in the Baltic Sea subordinated [to Sweden].
- 2. Through the commander of the [Swedish] 4th air force group regarding the exchange of intelligence and air situation-data regionally across the border.
- 3. Importation of special spare parts for Hawk.
- 4. The exchange of necessary communications documents at the regional and at the central level.
- 5. Loan of UHF radio gear.
- 6. Setting up direct telephone connections between Norwegian and Swedish air operations centres, and between regional commanders.
- 7. A decision on areas of responsibility for naval and air operations.
- 8. Reports every 24 hours on the situation for allied forces (through Swedish liaison team).
- 9. Request for reports on the effect of the allies' strikes on the aggressor's ports and air bases.
- 10. The importation of certain military equipment, e.g. Sidewinder missiles.
- 11. Request for support from allied air force assets against air bases, ports, and invasion craft.

- 12. Request for support by allied nuclear strikes on Finnish, Baltic, and Swedish territory.
- 13. Request for the transfer of allied ground troops in Norway to Sweden, as a strategic reserve.
- 14. Request for the basing of allied fighter units from southern Norway in Sweden, to be included in Sweden's air defences.
- 15. Request for the evacuation of evacuees from Kiruna through Narvik.
- 16. Request for the sharing of information on the intelligence-picture at allied headquarters regarding certain areas, as well as the tasking of allied intelligence services against certain targets.
